Important Dates:

March 6	Summer camp forms and details available at Parent-Camper Meeting
May 8	Last troop meeting for registration form and payment before late fee* Health forms are appreciated by this date to allow time for review
June 12 (7pm)	Pre-camp Meeting for all attending summer camp plus a parent *Bring any revised health forms so they can be handed in prior to camp!
June 24-30	Summer camp with Troop 39!

***Camp Cost:** Troop 39 will pay deposits to hold spaces at an early bird rate: \$415 this year. Payment in full and paperwork must be received by 5/8 meeting to secure a spot. After 5/15, the camp fee cost charged by Council is \$465 (additional fee does not pertain to new Crossover scouts). *Camperships are available for anyone for whom this cost presents a difficulty.*

Individual Scout Account (ISA) funds earned by wreath sales can be used, please note on registration form. If you would like to pay for camp using a credit card, follow the link on the troop site. Important: PayPal charges a 2.9% credit card plus \$.30 transaction fee so your credit card will be charged accordingly.

Merit Badges: Read the requirements *before* signing up for badges www.meritbadge.org. Pay particular attention to any age restrictions. **Pre-requisites for many of the badges are listed online (JNW and troop site).** Once merit badge decisions are made, reserve the merit badge pamphlets with the Troop Librarian (Conor MacCluggage), purchase them at the Scout Store or download online.

Required Forms:

1. Troop Registration Form, handed in with payment due no later than 5/8 (CRC has \$50 late fee)
2. BSA Annual Health and Medical Record
 - Part A, B, C and D are required
 - Part C physician **signature only** may be substituted by a SIGNED State of Connecticut blue form dated after 6/24/17
 - ALL signatures on all forms **must be dated after 6/24/17**
 - Copy of front and back of insurance card required
3. Medications and Allergy Treatment Plan: Medications can be listed on Part B; form **MUST** be signed by physician. Alternately, a separate use Medication and Allergy Treatment Plan form is available on the troop or camp site (submit one per medication).
